## Western Michigan CPCU Chapter Scholarship Criteria 2021

Application and Eligibility Information

- 1. Applicants must complete the application form.
- 2. Applications must be returned to the Western Michigan CPCU Chapter Scholarship Committee by March 15, 2021.
- 3. Awarding of the scholarship will take place at the April or May Western Michigan CPCU Chapter Meeting. The recipient of the award is very strongly encouraged to be present.
- 4. The Western Michigan CPCU Chapter Scholarship Committee's decision is final.
- 5. The chapter may potentially award multiple scholarships.

## (Non-Member) Scholarship Criteria

- 1. Applicants should be from the Western Michigan area.
- 2. Applicants must be enrolled in a Michigan College or University and have declared a major in one of the following areas: Insurance, Business, Math, Information Technology, or Legal.
- 3. The applicant must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher and be at least a Junior.
- 4. The scholarship is a one-time award that is non-renewable.
- 5. The recipient of this scholarship must present the Western Michigan CPCU Chapter with proof of enrollment prior to receiving the scholarship money.

## Western Michigan CPCU Chapter Member Scholarship Criteria

- 1. Applicants must be either an active paid member or paid candidate member of the Western Michigan CPCU Chapter.
- 2. Scholarship funds must be used for an insurance-related purpose which is non-reimbursable by the applicant's employer. This includes, but is not limited to: Graduate program tuition/fees, class/book/test fees related to Insurance Institute classes, matriculation fees, CPCU meeting fees, CPCU educational event fees, etc.
- 3. The applicant must designate the amount of the scholarship requested and provide proof of the expense prior to receiving the scholarship money.
